The Olive Branch Police Department will hold its 10th annual FREE summer camp from June 1<sup>st</sup> to June 30<sup>th</sup>, officially known as "Camp B.U.I.L.D."

Camp B.U.I.L.D. stands for Body, Unity, Inner Self, Leadership and Development, which will be discussed during the four week camp. The camp will run from 7:00AM until 12:00PM each day. It's free to the first 110 students going into the 4<sup>th</sup> grade- 8<sup>th</sup> grade.

Campers must live in Olive Branch. Sign up by filling out and signing a Camp B.U.I.L.D. packet and returning it to the Olive Branch Police Station, located at 10470 HWY 178, or the school that the child attends. Schools include Olive Branch Intermediate, Olive Branch Middle, Pleasant Hill, Center Hill, Lewisburg, and Desoto Central. All students turning in their application should only turn in the rules sheet, with both the child's and parent's signature, and the application page. Please hold on to the first page as a reference of what will be covered while at camp. Only the students selected will be notified by one of the camp instructors within one week after the deadline. Each participant will receive a camp T-shirt; in addition to free snacks during the time they attend camp. The Olive Branch Intermediate School, located at 8361 Pigeon Roost Road (next to Lowes), will be used as the main drop-off and pick-up point for camp members. All campers must be picked up from the school no later than 12:30PM.

B- Body (will be devoted to lessons concerning building a healthy body)

U- Unity (will be devoted to lessons concerning teamwork and working together)

I- Inner self (will be devoted to lessons concerning self qualities, happiness, and awareness)

L- Leadership (will be devoted to lessons concerning how to encourage their team to work together)

D- Development (will be devoted to lessons on personal conduct skills)

Throughout each week there will be fun and games such as: (Wet Water Wednesday, Movie Friday, Kick Ball, and Basketball, just to name a few. The final week is (FUN WEEK) which will include: Field Day at the High School or soccer fields, a parade to City Hall, graduation (June 30<sup>th</sup>), and a cookout.
