REQUIREMENTS:

1. Complete a Camp B.U.I.L.D. application packet and **turn in pages 3 & 4** at the Olive Branch Police Department at 10470 Hwy 178 or at the school in which the child attends. The application must be complete with signatures of both parent/guardian and camper/student.

Schools included are: Olive Branch, Pleasant Hill, Center Hill, Lewisburg, and Desoto Central.

2. Applicant must be entering into 4th – 8th grade (beginning with the 2017 Fall school term).
3. Applicant must be Olive Branch resident.

The final week is “FUN WEEK” which includes Field Day (location to be announced), parade to City Hall, graduation on June 29th, and a cookout on June 30th.

CAMP B.U.I.L.D RULES

- No disrespecting instructors or guest speakers
~ *no talking back when corrected*
- No touching the private property of others
~ *stealing will not be tolerated*
- All campers must sign in when entering camp and sign out prior to leaving camp
~ *Parents: Upon early pickup of your child, please notify an instructor to sign them out for the day*
- No sandals or open-toed shoes allowed. Athletic shoes or tennis shoes must be worn due to the activities they will be participating in.
~ *On Wacky Wet Wednesday you may **bring** flip flops to wear, but you **must wear** athletic shoes*
- No bullying will be tolerated
- No fussing, fighting, hitting, pushing, shoving will be tolerated
~ *If you have a problem with another camper, notify an instructor or peer leader immediately*
- No drugs are allowed at camp
~ *Parents: If your child needs a medication administered during camp hours, it must fall under the following guidelines: medication must be physician prescribed in the original packaging with your child's name on it or an over-the-counter medication with written dosing instructions, only the recommended dose will be given. You must leave the medication and any instructions with a camp instructor. No child will be allowed to administer their own medication while at camp. If your child has an inhaler, the inhaler must be checked in on a daily basis for your child to participate in activities.*
- No foul language, name calling or “checking”
- No non-participation in camp activities
~ *Each camper may not like all the camp activities but in order for camp to be successful, everyone must participate in the activities*
- Raise your hand to ask a question
- No gang signs or anything that may be deemed gang-related
- No electronic devices such as cell phones, iPods, MP3 players, Zune, computers, Game Boys, etc. will not be allowed at camp. Camp B.U.I.L.D. will not be responsible for any items lost, damaged or stolen.
- No inappropriate clothing such as: sagging pants, short shorts, tight shirts, etc.
~ *Boys: Pants must fit properly without showing undergarments.*
~ *Girls: Shorts must allow the camper to be active without exposing themselves. Shirts that are tight, see-through, low-cut, or expose the belly button, when jumping or standing, are not allowed.*
- If your child has any problems during camp they are to notify Detective Carlos Wilson or any other instructor immediately. Please encourage your child to address any issue prior to leaving camp each day.
